

DARK GREEN AREAS

Dark Green Areas to be maintained by appointed factor and held in pro-indiviso ownership of all plots.

ANGLED HATCH IN OPEN SPACE
The angled hatch indicates a servitude right of access to underlying sewers.

CROSS HATCH IN OPEN SPACE
Rights reserved by Developer to add this area to the maintained open space in lieu of a turning head if the turning head isn't required by the local roads authority. In the event this area is required as a turning head there will be no perking allowed on this

PINK AREAS
Pink areas are prospectively adoptable highway hardstanding areas to be maintained by the Local Roads Authority.

BROWN AREAS
Brown areas are frontage planting areas which may contain planting or hardstanding.

RED LINES
Prospective ownership boundaries are shown in red.
